Plaintiff, a prisoner proceeding pro se, brings this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to Eastern District of California local rules.

ECF No. 198. Plaintiff requested additional time to file objections to the findings and recommendations, which have been received. ECF Nos. 200, 201.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304(f), this Court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Due to an error in the Clerk's Office, this case was inadvertently stayed and no action was taken on the case for a prolonged period of time. Due to the passage of time, the Court therefore REJECTS the Findings and Recommendations as moot.

2	1. The Findings and Recommendations filed May 8, 2013 (ECF No. 198), are
3	DENIED as moot;
4	2. Plaintiff's request for additional time to file objections (ECF No. 200) is
5	DENIED as moot; and
6	3. Plaintiff's motion for a temporary restraining order (ECF No. 193) and motion
7	to stay (ECF No. 197) are DENIED as moot.
8	4. The parties are directed to proceed with this action.by reviewing and
9	complying with the Magistrate Judge's April 13, 2018 Order (ECF No. 206).
