17 Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding with appointed counsel, brings this petition
18 for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 challenging the denial of parole.
19 Pending before the court is petitioner's unopposed motion for voluntary dismissal (Doc. 52) of
20 this action as moot. Petitioner states that he was ultimately granted parole with respect to his life
21 term in December 2008. While petitioner remains in custody pursuant to a different conviction


