statements shall be limited to five (5) pages and shall include the following:

1	1) the party's assessment whether the instant action is of the type that would
2	benefit from a settlement proceeding;
3	2) the party's assessment of what factors, if any, will prevent settlement of this
4	matter prior to trial; and
5	3) any additional information the court may find useful in determining whether to
6	set this matter for a settlement conference.
7	Should the Court determine this action to be appropriate for referral to the
8	Prisoner Settlement Program, the Court will set this matter for settlement conference before a
9	magistrate judge or district judge.
