Defendant's counsel offered to provide copies of plaintiff's exhibits, as well as copies of the defense exhibits. Defendant's counsel is directed to provide three (3) copies of each set of exhibits to Courtroom Deputy Casey Schultz no later than 3:00 p.m. on the Friday before trial.

Plaintiff also has renewed his request for the appointment of counsel. The court will request that the court's Pro Bono Panel administrator attempt to locate counsel for the limited purpose of trying this case beginning July 5, 2011, if the matter does not settle as a result of the further discussions between the parties immediately following hearing on April 27, 2011.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Plaintiff's request that the court waive witness fees and mileage is denied.
- 2. The parties are directed to inform the court of the status of further settlement negotiations within fourteen days of the date of this order.
- 3. Plaintiff's request for the appointment of counsel is submitted pending the notification ordered by number 2 above.
- 4. Assuming the case goes to trial, any motions in limine must be filed no later than June 14, 2011, with opposition due June 21. The motions will be heard on the first day of trial.
  - 5. Proposed voir dire and jury instructions are due June 21, 2011.
- 6. Defendant's counsel shall provide three (3) copies of each party's set of exhibits to Courtroom Deputy Casey Schultz no later than 3:00 p.m. on July 1, 2011.
  - 7. Trial is confirmed for July 5, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.
