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 19 This 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action arising from the alleged deprivation of minor plaintiffs PETER
 20 KOLESNIKOV, DINA KOLESNIKOVA, ALINA KOLESNIKOVA, INNA KOLESNIKOVA, ALEX
 21 VASYAKIN, LIANA VASYAKINA, and ERIC PARSONS (“CLAIMANTS”) constitutional and
 22 statutory rights, was filed by CLAIMANTS and their guardians ad litem ALEXANDR KOLESNIKOV,
 23 SR. and Victoria Parker (“PETITIONERS”). PETITIONERS seek this Court’s approval of a \$88,888.88
 24 compromise settlement for CLAIMANTS for their claims against defendants SACRAMENTO

1 JOHNSON (collectively “defendants”). The Judge held a hearing on the Petition for Minors’
2 Compromises on August 12, 2009.

3 Having carefully reviewed the entire file, and in accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §
4 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 73-305, the court orders as follows:

- 5 1. The Petition for Approval of Minors’ Compromise is GRANTED;
- 6 2. CLAIMANTS individual shares shall be deposited into a federally insured blocked
7 account and not withdrawn without a court order or until CLAIMANTS reach the age of majority;
- 8 3. Reimbursement of costs incurred on this case, equally shared by each CLAIMANT, shall
9 be paid to counsel, Mark E. Merin; and
- 10 4. Attorney’s fees in the amount of \$35,555.60 shall be paid to counsel, Mark E. Merin.
