See Local Rule 3-120(d). 20 21 Pursuant to Local Rule 3-120(f), a civil action which has not been commenced in 22 the proper division of a court may, on the court's own motion, be transferred to the proper 23 division of the court. Therefore, this action will be transferred to the Fresno Division of the 24 <sup>1</sup> The court notes that plaintiff names the Director of the California Department of 25 Corrections and Rehabilitation as a defendant in this case. While the Director resides within an area covered by the Sacramento division, plaintiff's complaint does not appear to state a valid 26 claim for relief against the Director.
