16	Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel in an action brought under 42
17	U.S.C. § 1983. On October 28, 2009, plaintiff filed a request for production of documents and
18	request for admissions. On November 2, 2009, plaintiff filed additional requests for production
19	of documents and requests for admissions.
20	The court has repeatedly warned plaintiff that interrogatories, requests for production,
21	requests for admission, responses and proofs of service thereof "shall not be filed with the clerk
22	until there is a proceeding in which the document or proof of service is at issue. When required
23	in a proceeding, only that part of the request and response that is in issue shall be filed." Local
24	Rules 33-250(c), 34-250(c) & 36-250(c). See also Nov. 24, 2008 Order; June 10, 2009 Order.
25	Plaintiff's continued failure to comply with the court's orders will result in a recommendation
26	that this action be dismissed pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).

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1	Plaintiff's October 28, 2009 and November 2, 2009 requests for production of documents
2	and requests for admissions are stricken and the Clerk of the Court shall make a notation on the
3	docket to that effect.
