3. Respondent shall file and serve an answer or motion responding to the application
 within 60 days from the date of this order. *See* Rule 4, Fed. R. Governing § 2254 Cases. An
 answer shall be accompanied by any and all transcripts or other documents relevant to the
 determination of the issues presented in the application. *See* Rule 5, Fed. R. Governing § 2254
 Cases.

6 4. If the response is an answer, petitioner's reply, if any, shall be filed and served within
7 30 days of service of an answer.

8 5. If the response is a motion, petitioner's opposition or statement of non-opposition
9 shall be filed and served within 30 days of service of the motion. Respondent shall have 15 days
10 to file and serve a reply to any opposition.

11 6. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send to petitioner the form habeas petition used12 in this court.
