The 21 evidentiary hearing was scheduled for December 8, 2010 22 On November 4, 2010, petitioner filed a motion and an amended motion to 23 proceed in forma pauperis, along with a declaration by counsel in which counsel stated that the 24 motion was being pursued in order to seek the court's assistance in securing the attendance of 25 necessary witnesses at the evidentiary hearing. Examination of the in forma pauperis application 26 and counsel's declaration reveals that petitioner is unable to afford the costs of suit.
