Also 20 pending before the court is a Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis. 21 Plaintiffs claim that they were unlawfully terminated from 22 their employment as apartment managers at Arden Bell Apartments. 23 Plaintiffs also aver that they are in the process of being 24 unlawfully evicted from their apartment at Arden Bell. 25 Plaintiffs fail to establish the grounds for invoking federal 26 jurisdiction. The Labor Code sections cited to by plaintiffs do

not govern wrongful eviction or wrongful termination. Plaintiffs should consider re-filing their complaint in the appropriate state court. Plaintiffs may find it helpful to seek legal representation through a legal services organization.

Accordingly, the court orders as follows:

- 1. Plaintiffs' Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order is DENIED.
- 2. The matter is REFERRED to the Honorable Edmund F. Brennan for all further pretrial proceedings, pursuant to L.R. 72-302(c)(21).
- 3. The Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis is also REFERRED to the Magistrate Judge assigned to this case.
