

1 Discovery, previously closed by this Court on March 16, 2012, is hereby reopened for the
2 limited purpose of Plaintiff deposing Defendants Mayfield, Parker, and Brandon, and a Federal
3 Rule of Civil Procedure (“Rule”) 30(b)(6) witness on California prison policies and procedures
4 for classifying gang associates and for removing names from the “gang associate” list. Plaintiff
5 may also, for the Rule 30(b)(6) witness, serve a subpoena duces tecum for production of all
6 written policies, procedures, and guidelines, etc., for validating someone as a gang member and
7 for removing someone from the “gang associate” list. The Parties shall make reasonable efforts
8 to take and conclude the depositions in Sacramento by the end of 2013.


