Petitioner, a federal prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed an application for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241. Petitioner alleges that he was convicted of illegal re-entry in violation of 8 U.S.C. § 1326. Petitioner requests that the court suspend his order of deportation.

District courts do not have habeas jurisdiction over orders of removal. Puri v. Gonzales, 464 F.3d 1038, 1040 (9th Cir. 2006). Jurisdiction to review orders of removal rests exclusively in the courts of appeals. Id. Accordingly, the court will order this action transferred to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals.
