19	deportation.
20	District courts do not have habeas jurisdiction over orders of removal. <u>Puri v.</u>
21	Gonzales, 464 F.3d 1038, 1040 (9th Cir. 2006). Jurisdiction to review orders of removal rests
22	exclusively in the courts of appeals. <u>Id.</u> Accordingly, the court will order this action transferred
23	to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals.
