14	This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff's Requests for Appointment of Counsel (#36) and
15	(#37), filed on December 31, 2008, and on January 12, 2009, respectively.
16	As the Court previously advised Plaintiff, the United States Supreme Court has ruled that
17	district courts lack authority to require counsel to represent indigent prisoners in § 1983 cases. Mallard
18	v. United States Dist. Court, 490 U.S. 296, 298 (1989). In exceptional circumstances, the court may
19	request counsel voluntarily to represent such a plaintiff. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(1); Terrell v. Brewer, 935
20	F.2d 1015, 1017 (9th Cir. 1991); Wood v. Housewright, 900 F.2d 1332, 1335-36 (9th Cir. 1990). The
21	Court again finds that there are no exceptional circumstances in this case. Accordingly,
22	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Requests for Appointment of Counsel (#36) and
23	(#37) are denied .
