The court has reviewed the applicable legal standards and, good cause appearing,

concludes that it is appropriate to adopt the proposed Findings and Recommendations in full. ///

6	3. Plaintiff's claims pursuant to Title VII and FEHA are dismissed without leave
7	to amend;

9	Disabilities Act are dismissed with leave to amend; and
10	5. Plaintiff is granted leave to file, within 60 days of the filing date of any order
11	adopting this recommendation, a Fourth Amended Complaint setting forth claims for
12	discrimination, hostile work environment, and retaliation pursuant to the Rehabilitation Act and
13	the Americans With Disabilities Act.
