See Local Rule 22 3-120(d). 23 Pursuant to Local Rule 3-120(f), a civil action which has not been commenced in 24 the proper division of a court may, on the court's own motion, be transferred to the proper 25 division of the court. Therefore, this action will be transferred to the Fresno Division of the ///// 26

1 court. In light of 1996 amendments to 28 U.S.C. § 1915, this court will not rule on plaintiff's 2 request to proceed in forma pauperis. 3 Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. This court has not ruled on plaintiff's request to proceed in forma pauperis; 4 2. This action is transferred to the United States District Court for the Eastern 5 District of California sitting in Fresno; and 6 7 3.
