MUNTZ, et al., 14 Respondents. ORDER 15 16 Petitioner is a state prisoner without counsel seeking a writ of habeas corpus. See 28 17 U.S.C. § 2254. He seeks leave to proceed in forma pauperis. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915. However, 18 petitioner has commenced this action in the wrong district. 19 Petitioner was convicted in the Cook County Superior Court in Illinois, but is confined 20 Chuckawalla Valley State Prison in Riverside County. Although the United States District Court 21 in the Central District of California and the United States District Court in the district where 22 petitioner was convicted both have jurisdiction, see Braden v. 30th Judicial Circuit Court, 410 23 U.S. 484, 499-500 (1973), witnesses and evidence necessary for the resolution of petitioner's 24 application are more readily available in the county of conviction, *Id.* at 499 n. 15; 28 U.S.C. 25 § 2241(d). ///// 26

Therefore, this court defers ruling on petitioner's application to proceed *in forma* pauperis, and transfers this action to the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division. 28 U.S.C. § 1404(a).

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that this action is transferred to the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division.
