

1 motions to be filed. The parties are cautioned, however, that the court will not look favorably
2 upon any request to extend these deadlines, and will not grant an extension of time without good
3 cause shown.

4 Accordingly, additional discovery requests may be served, as set forth in the prior
5 scheduling order (Doc. 14), up to and including February 1, 2010. Any necessary motions to
6 compel based on the new discovery requests must be filed on or before April 1, 2010.¹ Any
7 dispositive motions shall be filed on or before May 3, 2010.
