Examination of the above-entitled actions reveals that these two (2) actions are related within the meaning of Local Rule 83-123(a) (E.D. Cal. 1997). The actions involve some of the same parties, are based on the same or similar claims, and involve the same transaction or events.

Accordingly, the assignment of the matters to the same judge and magistrate judge is likely to effect a substantial savings of judicial effort and is also likely to be convenient for the parties.
