

Appellant's motion for appointment of counsel in this habeas corpus appeal is granted. *See* 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(2)(B); *Weygandt v. Look*, 718 F.2d 952, 954 (9th Cir. 1983) (per curiam). Counsel will be appointed by separate order.

The Clerk shall electronically serve this order on the appointing authority for the Eastern District of California, who will locate appointed counsel. The district court shall send notification of the name, address and telephone number of appointed counsel to the Clerk of this court at counselappointments@ca9.uscourts.gov within 14 days of locating counsel.

If new counsel identifies uncertified issues that should be raised on appeal, counsel shall include them in the opening brief as permitted by Ninth Circuit Rule 22-1(e).

The Clerk shall strike the informal opening brief filed on November 4, 2008. The Clerk shall provide a copy of the informal brief to the appointing authority for the Eastern District of California, for service on appointed counsel.

The opening brief and excerpts of record are due April 6, 2009; the answering brief is due May 6, 2009; and the optional reply brief is due within 14 days after service of the answering brief.
