entire file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The findings and recommendations filed October 28, 2008, are adopted in full;
- 2. This action is dismissed as to defendants Woodford, Felker, Dangler, Roche, Grannis and McDonald for plaintiff's failure to state a cognizable claim against them. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 1915A; *see also Lopez v. Smith*, 203 F.3d 1122, 1128 (9th Cir. 2000) (indigent prisoner proceeding without counsel must be given leave to file amended complaint unless the court can rule out any possibility that the plaintiff could state a claim).
