16	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action
17	seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate
18	Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.
19	On February 25, 2010, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations
20	herein which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any
21	objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days from the
22	date the findings and recommendations were served. Defendants have filed untimely objections
23	to the findings and recommendations. In an abundance of caution, the court has considered the
24	untimely objections.
25	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § $636(b)(1)(C)$ and Local Rule
26	304, this court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire

1	file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by
2	proper analysis.

4	1. The findings and recommendations filed February 25, 2010 are adopted in full;
