represents compensation for all legal services rendered on behalf of Plaintiff by counsel in connection with this civil action, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d).

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1	This stipulation constitutes a compromise settlement of Plaintiff's request for EAJA attorney
2	fees, and does not constitute an admission of liability on the part of Defendant under the EAJA.
3	Payment of FIVE THOUSAND dollars and 00/100 cents (\$5,000.00) in EAJA attorney fees, shall
4	constitute a complete release from and bar to any and all claims Plaintiff may have relating to EAJA fees
5	in connection with this action. Any payment shall be made payable to Plaintiff's counsel as Plaintiff's
6	assignee and delivered to Plaintiff's counsel.
7	This award is without prejudice to the rights of Plaintiff's counsel to seek Social Security Act
8	attorney fees under 42 U.S.C. § 406, subject to the provisions of the EAJA.
