Plaintiff, a federal prisoner currently confined at the Sacramento County Main

17 Jail, has filed an action seeking relief pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On December 11, 2007, this
18 court dismissed plaintiff's complaint because the allegations therein were so vague and
19 conclusory that the court was unable to determine whether the current action is frivolous or fails
20 to state a claim for relief.


21 On December 19, 2007, plaintiff filed a motion to compel. Plaintiff requests from
22 defendants “1 - The complete Medical Records of Plaintiff; 2 - A listing of Respondent’s Assets,
23 Bank Accounts, Insurance Policies Statement; 3 - Depositions Minutes.” Plaintiff’s motion is
24 premature. The court has not ordered service upon any defendants named in this action nor has
25 the court issued a discovery order. Accordingly, plaintiff’s motion to compel will be denied.
