1	(A) shows in the detail prescribed by Form 4 of the Appendix of Forms the party's inability to pay or to give security for fees and	
2	costs;	
3	(B) claims an entitlement to redress; and	
4	(C) states the issues that the party intends to present on appeal.	
5	Fed. R. App. P. 24(a)(2). Petitioner's application to proceed in forma pauperis demonstrates his	
6	inability to pay or to give security for fees and costs. In addition, in this court's December 23,	
7	2009 order, liberally construing petitioner's notice of appeal and granting his request for a	
8	certificate of appealability, the court explained the issues to be presented on appeal. In this	
9	regard, the requirements of Fed. R. App. P. 24(a) have been satisfied. Accordingly, petitioner's	
10	motion to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal will be granted.	
11	In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petitioner's	
12	January 28, 2010 motion to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal is granted.
