1 Plaintiffs Conservation Congress and Klamath Forest Alliance and Federal Defendant  
2 United States Forest Service submit this Stipulation and Proposed Order, pursuant to L.R. 144,  
3 granting a short extension of the briefing schedule for Defendant's Motion for Judgment on the  
4 Pleadings [Dkt. #61]. In support of this Stipulation, the parties represent as follows:

5 1. Plaintiffs' opposition to Defendant's motion is currently due May 10, 2010, and  
6 Defendant's reply is due May 17, 2010. (*See* Stipulation and Order Continuing Hearing on  
7 Defendant's Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings [Dkt. #64] ¶ 3.)

8 2. Plaintiffs' counsel has informed Defendant's counsel that, due to computer  
9 problems encountered the weekend of May 8<sup>th</sup> and continuing on May 10<sup>th</sup>, together with an  
10 anticipated absence from the office on May 11<sup>th</sup>, she will not be able to file her opposition until  
11 May 12<sup>th</sup>.

12 3. Defendant's counsel will be out of the office on Wednesday, May 19<sup>th</sup> (one week  
13 from May 12<sup>th</sup>) and has brief in another case due May 20<sup>th</sup>.

14 4. Accordingly, the parties request, subject to Court approval, that Plaintiffs be  
15 permitted to file their opposition on May 12, 2010, and that Defendant be permitted to file its  
16 reply on May 21, 2010.

17 5. The proposed extension will not affect the hearing date on Defendant's motion,  
18 which is currently set for June 21, 2010 [Dkt. #64 ¶ 2]. The prior request for continuance of the  
19 hearing on Defendant's motion did not request any extension of the briefing schedule at that  
20 time.
