On January 17, 2008, Plaintiff Herbert O. Allen, proceeding *pro se*, brought this prisoner civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On March 11, 2009, the Court issued an Order Denying Plaintiff's Request for Service of Process (Doc. No. 12). On March 31, 2009, the mail was returned to the Court as undeliverable. Since then, Plaintiff has not communicated with the Court nor has Plaintiff provided the Court with a current mailing address.
