12 ORDER DISMISSING ACTION

13 The record reflects that on July 16, 2009, Plaintiff Wayne Wright's
14 Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis (IFP) was denied without prejudice and
15 the Complaint was dismissed with leave granted to file an Amended Complaint.
16 Plaintiff was given 30 days to file a new IFP Application and an Amended
17 Complaint. Plaintiff was notified that if a new IFP Application or an Amended
18 Complaint was not timely filed, the action would be subject to closure. It has been
19 over six weeks and neither an Amended Complaint nor a new IFP Application has
20 been filed. Accordingly, the Court DISMISSES the ACTION and directs the Clerk
