See Order (June 30, 2023), Case No. 08-0593, ECF No. 305; Case 27 No. 10-2139, ECF No. 384; Mot. Recons., Case No. 08-0593, ECF No. 308; Case No. 10-2139,

ECF No. 384. Plaintiff does not explain the reasoning behind his request for reconsideration.

The court has reviewed the Magistrate Judge's orders and perceives neither clear error nor any decision contrary to law. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(a); 29 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A). The motions for reconsideration are **denied**.
