17	Plaintiff is a state prisoner seeking relief pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On March 14,		
18	2016, plaintiff was appointed a pro bono attorney, Brian Pomerantz, to represent him in this		
19	matter. ¹ (ECF No. 51.) Since then, plaintiff has filed several pro se motions. (ECF Nos. 54, 63		
20	& 62; <u>see also</u> ECF Nos. 57, 58 & 64.)		
21	Mr. Pomerantz recently filed a motion to withdraw as plaintiff's attorney. (ECF No. 61.)		
22	The court has yet to rule on that motion and, to date, plaintiff continues to be represented by		
23	counsel. See L.R. 182(d) ("The authority and duty of the attorney of record shall continue until		
24	relieved by order of the Court issued hereunder.") Thus the court will disregard plaintiff's		
25	unauthorized pro se filings. Specifically, the court will deny plaintiff's motions without prejudice		
26	to renewal, either through counsel or at such time as plaintiff is proceeding pro se. Any
