PLAINTIFF AND AGAINST DEFENDANT 16 17 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, by and between the parties, through their respective 18 counsel of record, that this action be remanded to the Commissioner of Social Security for 19 further administrative action pursuant to section 205(g) of the Social Security Act, as amended, 20 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), sentence four. 2.1 On remand, the Appeals Counsel will instruct the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") to take the following action: 22 The ALJ will reevaluate the treating, examining and reviewing physician opinion 23 evidence, including opinions from Liana Turkot, M.D., Mandeep Behniwal, M.D., Michelina 2.4 Regazzi, Ph.D., and Rosemary Tyl, M.D. The ALJ may request the treating and examining 25 sources to provide additional evidence and/or to further clarify their opinions. The ALJ will 26 reconsider Plaintiff's RFC and provide a function by function assessment for the entire period at 27 28

	issue. The ALJ will give further consideration to the record concerning Plaintiff's past relevant	
1	work and clarify plaintiff's past relevant work. If warranted, the ALJ will obtain vocational	
2	expert testimony to clarify the effect of Plaintiff's assessed limitations on the occupational base.	
3	The ALJ will ask the vocational expert whether the jobs identified conflict with descriptions	
4	contained in the Dictionary of Occupational Titles.	
5	The parties further request that the Clerk of the Court be directed to enter a final	
6	judgment in favor of plaintiff, and against defendant, Commissioner of Social Security, reversing	
7	the final decision of the Commissioner.
