17	Petitioner's application for writ of habeas corpus brought pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §
18	2254 was denied, and judgment entered, on December 13, 2010. Petitioner filed a notice of
19	appeal with respect to that decision and his appeal has been processed to the Ninth Circuit.
20	On January 14, 2010, petitioner filed a motion to proceed on appeal in forma
21	pauperis accompanied by an affidavit containing a statement of all assets. Petitioner's
22	declaration makes the showing required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1). Because he is a prisoner,
23	however, petitioner must additionally comply with section (a)(2), which requires that
24	A prisoner seeking to bring a civil action or appeal a judgment in a civil action or proceeding without prepayment of fees or security
25	therefor, in addition to filing the affidavit filed under paragraph (1), shall submit a certified copy of the trust fund account statement (or
26	institutional equivalent) for the prisoner for the 6-month period
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1 2	immediately preceding the filing of the complaint or notice of appeal, obtained from the appropriate official of each prison at which the prisoner is or was confined.
3	28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2).
4	Accordingly, petitioner's January 14, 2011 motion to proceed in forma pauperis
5	on appeal is denied at this time, without prejudice to its renewal upon submission of petitioner's
6	trust fund account statement.
7	IT IS SO ORDERED.
