5	of Submission of Documents and submit the following documents to the court:
6	a. The complete Notice of Submission of Documents;
7	b. One completed summons;
8	c. One completed USM-285 form for each defendant; and
9	d. Six copies of the endorsed Second Amended Complaint.
10 11	5. Plaintiff need not attempt service on defendants and need not request waiver of service.

	Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the court will direct the United States Marshal
13	to serve the above-named defendants pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4 without
14	payment of costs.
