
ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS

On August 18, 2009, the Court received Plaintiff's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. (Dkt. No. 14.) Plaintiff's complaint seeks relief pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The Court orders as follows:

- (2) The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Order to Plaintiff and to issue summonses to Plaintiff to enable proper service of the complaint on the appropriate parties.
