17	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a motion entitled "Motion for 6		
18	Months Priority Law Library Status." (ECF No. 275.) In his motion, plaintiff alleges that a court		
19	order is necessary before he can use the law library and he therefore requests that the court issue		
20	an order granting him "Preferred Legal User" status.		
21	Plaintiff requests PLU status in order to prepare for his trial, which is set for February		
22	2016. (ECF No. 264.) In May 2015, however, plaintiff is not under a present obligation to		
23	submit documents and thus has not demonstrated that his right of access to the courts is being		
24	impaired. The court will not order that plaintiff be granted six months' PLU status at this time.		
25	However, plaintiff may renew his motion for PLU status later this year, covering the six-month		
26	period before trial, and the court will reconsider his request.
