16	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, is obligated to pay the	
17	statutory filing fee of \$350.00 for this action. Plaintiff has been assessed an initial partial filing fee of	
18	\$1.20 for this action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(1). Upon payment of that initial partial filing fee,	
19	plaintiff will be obligated to make monthly payments in the amount of twenty percent (20%) of the	
20	preceding month's income credited to plaintiff's trust account. The California Department of	
21	Corrections and Rehabilitation is required to send to the Clerk of the Court the initial partial filing fee	
22	and thereafter payments from plaintiff's prison trust account each time the amount in the account	
23	exceeds \$10.00, until the statutory filing fee of \$350.00 is paid in full. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2).	
24	Good cause appearing therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
25	1. The Director of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation or a	
26	designee shall collect from plaintiff's prison trust account an initial partial filing fee in the amount of	
27	\$1.20 and shall forward the amount to the Clerk of the Court. Said payment shall be clearly identified	
28	by the name and number assigned to this action.

- 2. Thereafter, the Director of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation or a designee shall collect from plaintiff's prison trust account the \$348.80 balance of the filing fee by collecting monthly payments from plaintiff's prison trust account in an amount equal to twenty percent (20%) of the preceding month's income credited to the prisoner's trust account and forwarding payments to the Clerk of the Court each time the amount in the account exceeds \$10.00 in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2). The payments shall be clearly identified by the name and number assigned to this action.
- 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order and a copy of plaintiff's signed in forma pauperis affidavit on Director, California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, 1515 S Street, Sacramento, California 95814.
- 4. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on the Financial Department of the court.
