On August 17, 2009, the court issued a minute order in this action giving plaintiff Melvin Rosales until August 31, 2009, to amend plaintiff's declarations in support of his opposition to defendant's motion for summary judgment. 5 than 5:00 p.m. on September 28, 2009;

6 2) Defendant shall file any reply no later than 5:00  
7 p.m. on October 5, 2009;

8 3) Further hearing on defendant's motion for summary  
9 judgment is continued to October 13, 2009, at 2:00 p.m. in  
10 courtroom 5;

11 4) The Pretrial Conference set for September 21, 2009,  
12 at 2:00 p.m. is hereby vacated and reset for January 11, 2010, at  
13 2:00 p.m.; and

14 5) The trial date of November 3, 2009, is hereby  
15 vacated and reset for March 9, 2010, at 9:00 a.m.
