14	Plaintiff has requested the appointment of counsel. United States District Courts
15	lack authority to require counsel to represent indigent prisoners in § 1983 cases. Mallard v.
16	United States Dist. Court, 490 U.S. 296, 298 (1989). In certain exceptional circumstances, the
17	court may request the voluntary assistance of counsel pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(1). Terrell
18	v. Brewer, 935 F.2d 1015, 1017 (9th Cir. 1991); Wood v. Housewright, 900 F.2d 1332, 1335-36
19	(9th Cir. 1990). In the present case, the court does not find the required exceptional
20	circumstances exist at this time.
21	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff's request for the
22	appointment of counsel is denied.
