12	On July 30, 2009, a report and recommendation (#15) was entered recommending that
13	plaintiff's complaint (#1) proceed as to the following defendants and claims:
14	1. Plaintiff's Fourteenth Amendment claims against defendants Smith, Peddicord,
15	Beasley, Kemp, Wright, Chapman, and McGrath;
16	2. Plaintiff's First Amendment retaliation claims against defendants Smith and
17	McGuire;
18	3. Plaintiff's First Amendment Access to the Courts claims against defendant
19	Peddicord, Wagner, and Rausch;
20	4. Plaintff's Eighth Amendment excessive force claim against defendant McGuire;
21	and
22	5. Plaintiff's Eighth Amendment deliberate indifference claims against defendants
23	Callison and Craddock.
24	On October 26, 2009, the District Court accepted and adopted the report and
25	recommendation and ordered that plaintiff's claims were permitted to proceed as stated therein
26	(#20).

1	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
2	1. Service of the complaint (#1) is appropriate for the following defendants: J.
3	Smith, D. Peddicord, Beasley, R. Kemp, E. Rausch, M. Wright, D. McGuire, Callison, R.
4	Craddock, D. Chapman, and Joe McGrath.
5	2. The Clerk of the Court shall send plaintiff eleven USM-285 forms, eleven
6	summons, an instruction sheet and a copy of the complaint (#1), a copy of the report and
7	recommendation (#15), and a copy of the court's order (#20).
8	3. Within thirty days from the date of this order, plaintiff shall complete the attached
9	Notice of Submission of Documents and submit all of the following documents to the court at the
10	same time:
11	a. The completed, signed Notice of Submission of Documents;
12	b. Eleven completed summons;
13	c. Eleven completed USM-285 forms, one for each defendant listed in
14	number 1 above; and
15	d. Eleven copies of the complaint $(#1)$ , the report and recommendation $(#15)$ ,
16	and the court's order (#20).
17	4. Plaintiff shall not attempt to effect service of the complaint on defendants or
18	request a waiver of service of summons from any defendant. Upon receipt of the above-described
19	documents, the court will direct the United States Marshal to serve the above-named defendants
20	pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4 without payment of costs.
