15	Petitioner is a state prisoner without counsel seeking a writ of habeas corpus. See 28
16	U.S.C. § 2254. Petitioner has inquired whether the court will appoint him counsel. There
17	currently exists no absolute right to appointment of counsel in habeas proceedings. See Nevius v.
18	Sumner, 105 F.3d 453, 460 (9th Cir. 1996). The court may appointment counsel at any stage of
19	the proceedings "if the interests of justice so require." See 18 U.S.C. § 3006A; see also, Rule
20	8(c), Rules Governing Section 2254 Cases. The court does not find that the interests of justice
21	would be served by the appointment of counsel at this stage of the proceedings.
22	Accordingly, it hereby is ORDERED that petitioner's January 19, 2010, request for
23	appointment of counsel is denied without prejudice.
