refutes the assertion. Plaintiff alleges that, on a date nearly two years prior to the filing of his complaint, he was denied access to an elevator in the Yard 1 & 2 Education building at California State Prison - Solano. Ultimately, he alleges, he fell down the stairs injuring his back. He further alleges that he has subsequently been transferred to the High Desert State Prison. Plaintiff alleges that he has been treated for his injuries. The present complaint concerns the asserted continued denial of elevator access at a prison where the defendant is no longer housed. Accordingly, as the present complaint alleges facts establishing that the plaintiff is not under imminent danger of serious physical injury,

THE COURT **ORDERS** that Plaintiff's Request to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* (#2) is DENIED;

THE COURT FURTHER **ORDERS** that Plaintiff's Complaint (#1) is DISMISSED.

THE COURT FURTHER **ORDERS** that Plaintiff's Motion to Appoint Counsel (#7) is DENIED.
