(PRETRIAL SCHEDULING)

This action has been referred to the undersigned magistrate judge pursuant to
Local Rule 72-302(c)(21) for all purposes encompassed by that provision.

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 16 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, IT
IS ORDERED that:

1. A Status (Pretrial Scheduling) Conference is set for **Friday, February 5, 2010,**
at 11:00 a.m., in Courtroom No. 27, before the undersigned.

2. All parties shall appear at the Status Conference either in person or
telephonically. To arrange telephonic appearance, the party shall contact Pete Buzo, the
courtroom deputy of the undersigned, at (916) 930-4128 no later than 48 hours before the Status
(Pretrial Scheduling) Conference.

1 3. Plaintiff shall file and serve a status report on or before **January 22, 2009**, and
2 defendant Ghoman shall file and serve a status report on or before **January 29, 2009**. Each
3 status report shall address all of the following matters:

- 4 a. Progress of service of process;
- 5 b. Possible joinder of additional parties;
- 6 c. Any expected or desired amendment of the
7 pleadings;
- 8 d. Jurisdiction and venue;
- 9 e. Anticipated motions and the scheduling thereof;
- 10 f. Anticipated discovery and the scheduling thereof,
including disclosure of expert witnesses;
- 11 g. Future proceedings, including the setting of
12 appropriate cut-off dates for discovery and for law
and motion, and the scheduling of a final pretrial
13 conference and trial;
- 14 h. Modification of standard pretrial procedures
specified by the rules due to the relative simplicity
15 or complexity of the action;
- 16 i. Whether the case is related to any other case,
including matters in bankruptcy;
- 17 j. Whether the parties will stipulate to the assigned
18 magistrate judge acting as settlement judge, waiving
any disqualification by virtue of his so acting, or
19 whether they prefer to have a Settlement Conference
before another magistrate judge;
- 20 k. Whether the parties intend to consent to proceed
before a United States Magistrate Judge; and
- 21 l. Any other matters that may aid in the just and
22 expeditious disposition of this action.
