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16	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action
17	seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate
18	Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.
19	On September 10, 2012, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations
20	herein which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any
21	objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Neither
22	party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations.
23	The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be
24	supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY
25	ORDERED that:
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1	1. The findings and recommendations filed September 10, 2012, are adopted in
2	full;
3	2. The September 28, 2010 order granting defendant Flohr's motion for summary
4	judgment (Dckt. No. 42) is vacated;
5	3. Defendant Flohr's motion for summary judgment (Dckt. No. 26) is denied
6	without prejudice;
7	4. Within fourteen days of this order, defendants are allowed to file and serve a
8	single motion for summary judgment that includes the notice to plaintiff required by Woods;
9	5. Plaintiff must file and serve his opposition within thirty days thereafter; and
10	6. Defendants may file a reply within fourteen days thereafter.
