16	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a civil rights action pursuant	
17	to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On November 17, 2008, plaintiff was directed to submit an application to	
18	proceed in forma pauperis. Plaintiff has now filed a request for leave to proceed in forma	
19	pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. Plaintiff has not, however, filed a certified copy of his	
20	prison trust account statement for the six month period immediately preceding the filing of the	
21	complaint and obtained the certification required on the application form. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C.	
22	§ 1915(a)(2). Plaintiff will be provided the opportunity to submit the completed application and	
23	the certified copy in support of his application to proceed in forma pauperis.	
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In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, a certified copy of his prison trust account statement for the six month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint and the certification required on the application form. Plaintiff's failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed without prejudice.

2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner.
