23	On June 8, 2010, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations in <u>Galtieri-</u>	
24	Carlson v. Victoria M. Morton Enters., et al., No. 2:08-cv-01777 FCD KJN PS, which were

The Proposed Findings and Recommendations filed June 8, 2010, are ADOPTED;
 The motion for voluntary dismissal is granted and defendant Victoria Morton, an

individual, is dismissed without prejudice from <u>Galtieri-Carlson v. Victoria M. Morton Enters.</u>,
 <u>et al.</u>, No. 2:08-cv-01777 FCD KJN PS.
