Lawrence K. 24 25 Karlton of the above-captioned Court (or the successor in 26 Courtroom 4, or, if none, another District Court Judge of the 27 above-captioned Court) shall retain jurisdiction to enforce the 28 terms of the Settlement Agreement." 1

The parties appear not to have filed the referenced Settlement Agreement with the court, and the court refuses to retain jurisdiction over a Settlement Agreement that it has had no opportunity to review. Accordingly, the court DECLINES to enter the proposed order.
