On January 18, 2011, the remaining Defendant filed a motion for summary judgment. The Plaintiff did not file an opposition to the motion. In its June 17, 2011 order, the Court noted this fact, and granted Plaintiff twenty-one (21) days to file an opposition. The Plaintiff did not do so, but instead filed a motion to dismiss the complaint without prejudice. Defendants did not object to dismissal, so long as it was with prejudice. In the alternative, Defendants requested a ruling on their motion for summary judgment.

Given the Plaintiff's decision not to contest the motion for summary judgment and Plaintiff's subsequent motion to dismiss his claims voluntarily, the Court hereby DISMISSES the action with prejudice. All other pending motions are denied as moot. Each party shall bear its own costs.
