1 WHEREAS the Parties have met and conferred regarding discovery and other issues, 2 and the Plaintiff has exchanged medical records and other evidence with the Defendants as well 3 as settled some of the property claims, 4 The Parties request a 60 day continuance of the Status (pretrial scheduling) Conference 5 in order to attempt to settle the remaining issues of the complaint.
