26 Rule 83-123(a)(1), (2), (3), and (4). For the reasons set forth in


1 the government's Notice of Related Cases, the assignment of the

8 effected. Under the regular practice of this court, related cases
9 are generally assigned to the judge to whom the first filed action
10 was assigned.

11 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the action denominated CIV. NO.

13 Lawrence K. Karlton and Magistrate Judge Gregory G. Hollows for
14 all further proceedings. Henceforth the caption on all documents
