17	Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding through counsel, has filed a timely notice of	
18	appeal of this court's order denying his application for writ of habeas corpus.	
19	On April 22, 2010, petitioner filed two motions requesting in forma pauperis	
20	status on appeal. The first, docketed 16, was accompanied by an exhibit obviously intended for	
21	another case. The second, docketed 18, was accompanied by an affidavit which meets the	
22	requirements of 28 U.S.C. §1915(a)(1). Because of his status as a prisoner, however, petitioner	
23	must submit, in addition to the affidavit required by §1915(a)(1), "a certified copy of the trust	
24	fund account statement (or institutional equivalent) for the prisoner for the 6-month period	
25	immediately preceding the filing of the complaint or notice of appeal, obtained from the	
26	appropriate official of each prison at which the prisoner is or was confined." 28 U.S.C.

Accordingly, petitioner's April 22, 2010 motions to proceed in forma pauperis on

appeal are denied at this time.
